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H1N1 Flu Virus: What They Don't Tell You

With the fall season for immune challenges coming (I hate calling it flu season!), there is growing concern over the H1N1 Virus. With our kids returning back to school, the contact rate for all viruses will be increasing. There are increasing concerns in the media over possible side effects with certain flu vaccines. The following is from the London Daily Mail - 8/15/09

A warning that the new swine flu jab is linked to a deadly nerve disease has been sent by the Government to senior neurologists in a confidential letter.

The letter from the Health Protection Agency, the official body that oversees public health, has been leaked to The Mail on Sunday, leading to demands to know why the information has not been given to the public before the vaccination of millions of people, including children, begins.

It tells the neurologists that they must be alert for an increase in a brain disorder called Guillain-Barre Syndrome (GBS), which could be triggered by the vaccine. GBS attacks the lining of the nerves, causing paralysis and inability to breathe, and can be fatal.

The letter, sent to about 600 neurologists on July 29, is the first sign that there is concern at the highest levels that the vaccine itself could cause serious complications. It refers to the use of a similar swine flu vaccine in the United States in 1976 when:

- * More people died from the vaccination than from swine flu.
- * 500 cases of GBS were detected.

* The vaccine may have increased the risk of contracting GBS by eight times.

* The vaccine was withdrawn after just ten weeks when the link with GBS became clear.

* The US Government was forced to pay out millions of dollars to those affected.

Concerns have already been raised that the new vaccine has not been sufficiently tested and that the effects, especially on children, are unknown.

It is being developed by pharmaceutical companies and will be given to about 13 million people during the first wave of immunization.

Top priority will be given to everyone aged six months to 65 with an underlying health problem, pregnant women and health professionals.....

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HcG Weight Loss Therapy...Does It Work?

YES! Many successes have been achieved using A.T.W. Simeons HcG therapy with lasting results. Most HcG dieters report a minimum loss of 1 to 2 lbs a day (sorry girls, guys seem to lose more). In addition to the loss of unwanted fat, long term, easily maintained weight loss is achieved because the metabolism is reset and the dieter now has a healthier relationship with food.

HcG stands for Human Chorionic Gonadotropin, a hormone that is present in women but at times is used for therapeutic purposes in some men. During pregnancy, this hormone is produced in large quantities and almost totally controls a woman's metabolic functions. When not pregnant, the body still responds to the hormone in much the same way by increasing the metabolism and metabolizing fat cells to be used or eliminated. Because the body will want to immediately take on more fat, it is very important to follow the diet as outlined by the program. In addition to the HcG treatments, following the diet and exercise will greatly increase your success.



For the first three weeks of the diet all foods are allowed except starch and sugar in any form. After three weeks, starch can be gradually added in small quantities. Prior to treatment a list of acceptable foods will be thoroughly discussed as well as other protocols that will enhance weight loss. Hunger will be at its worst for the first two days, but by the second week, the body has become accustomed to the decreased caloric intake.

HcG is administered sublingually, by injection or by infusion. Although sublingual HcG is frequently used, it does not seem to be as effective because much of the hormone is lost in the intestines. Many healthcare providers allow individuals to inject the solution themselves. Most self-injections are done in the subcutaneous tissue and not in the muscle. Unfortunately this method is usually met in failure because the HcG only reaches the fat tissue and not the brain where it is able to produce results.

If you decide to receive HcG therapy we recommend daily muscular injections of 175u or better yet intravenously. Instead of the daily injections, patients in our clinic have the option to receive one IV of 1500u per week for a minimum of 3 weeks. Using this method other nutrients can be added to ensure you are maintaining proper micronutrient levels throughout your treatment. If you prefer the daily muscular injections, they will be given six days on and one day off for a minimum of 23 or a maximum of 40 injections, depending on your weight loss requirements. Again, sublingual HcG is effective and many find it works well for them and are pleased with their results. You must decide which method will work the best for you!

Acupuncture is most effective at treating pain, such as post-operative dental pain, headaches, tennis elbow, or muscle pain. It also can be used to treat symptoms of fibromyalgia, pain from shingles, nausea and vomiting, as well as alleviate addiction symptoms from alcohol or other drugs.

Most people feel minimal discomfort, if any, during an acupuncture session. Some people find the treatment relaxing, while others find it energizing.

Depending on the type and location of pain you are experiencing, we may also recommend homeopathic injectable medicines as an adjunct to your acupuncture treatment. These injections are often used to alleviate difficult pain symptoms and sensations with no adverse side effects.
